What? Voice and 'action'

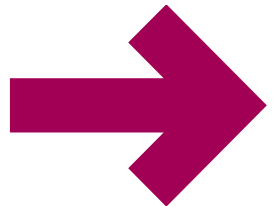
Why?

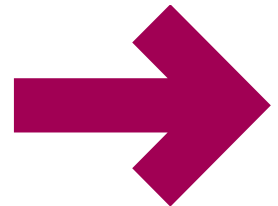
